

# Student book keeps precious memories

Mrs Cornfoot said the duo designed the book when Mrs Collie's children were starting school and she could not find a school record book that was stylish and functional.

"After the success of *A Book About Me* we decided to do something for school-age children as well," Mrs Cornfoot said.

"We designed it with a chunky spine so it can fit a lot. Each year level has a pocket for storing things, like school photos, reports or drawings.
